Goin' to Kansas City:

Might take a plane—

Fly in to Kansas City International Airport (MCI)

The airport is about 30 miles north of downtown. There is shuttle service to the hotel. (Super Shuttle \$17 one-way or \$29 round-trip). Or, you may wish to rent a car. Kansas City is very drivable and there is ample parking at the hotel. (Self-park \$14.50/day).

Private small aircraft can land at Kansas City's downtown airport just minutes from the hotel.

Might take a train—

Yes, you still can. Amtrak service stops at Union Station, just two blocks from our hotel.

Might take a car—

Conveniently located midway between California and New York, all roads lead to Kansas City. (Hotel self-parking \$14.50/day)
Easy access from Interstates 70 and 35 and from MO Highway 71.

Kansas City is very drivable, and you may want to consider renting a car even if you are arriving by plane or train.
