## REQUIREMENTS

### 1) TRANSCRIPTS

- High School Seniors: You must submit an official high school transcript. (Most transcripts include either ACT or SAT test scores. These scores are not required for the application, but students are strongly encouraged to include these if available.)
- College Freshman (at time of application): You must submit an official high school transcript. You may submit an official college transcript in addition to the high school transcript.
- College Sophomores, Juniors, & Seniors (at time of application): You must submit an official college transcript.

### 2) LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION

The applicant's pastor must send a letter indicating the applicant is a full member of the United Methodist Church and is of suitable character to be considered for a scholarship. If the applicant is the child of his/her pastor, the letter should be submitted by an officer of the church or a peer pastor.

### 3) APPLICANT STATEMENT

The applicant must submit a **one-page** statement describing his/her course of study and goals for the future.

### 4) PHOTOGRAPH

The applicant must include a photograph for publication purposes. This photograph may be a professional portrait or a snapshot in color or black and white, but should be clear and printed on photo quality paper. Photos will not be forwarded to the scholarship committee and are only used to recognize award recipients in Foundation publications. Photos will not be returned.

**All materials (application form, transcript, letter of recommendation, applicant statement and photograph) must be postmarked by the deadline of April 1<sup>st</sup>.** No exceptions to the deadline. Mail materials and application form to:
